



IMA Faculty Leadership Award Distinguished Service Award for Educators

The IMA Faculty Leadership Award recognizes a faculty member who has demonstrated exemplary leadership within and service to the IMA. IMA annually recognizes a faculty member that has demonstrated significant leadership activities at the national, regional, and/or local levels of the IMA and made additional contributions to the IMA. The additional contributions may take a variety of forms and include a variety of different activities. For example, these activities may include:

- Support of student participation in the IMA, including:
 1. support of IMA student chapters,
 2. leadership, participation, and support of the Annual Student Case Competition,
 3. leadership, participation, and support of the Annual Student Conference and/or the IMA Annual Conference,
 4. recruiting of students into meaningful participation in the IMA
- Promotion and support of the CMA program
- Leadership, participation, and support of the IMA Annual Conference and other IMA (regional and/or local) professional education activities
- Promotion and support of IMA activities (on national, regional, and/or local levels)
- Research and writing in IMA publications (such as *Strategic Finance* and *Management Accounting Quarterly*) and/or other IMA-sponsored research
