

## Carl Menconi Ethics Case Writing Competition Call for Submissions

The Institute of Management Accountants (IMA) Committee on Ethics is proud to announce the Carl Menconi Ethics Case Competition. The Competition is named in memory of Mr. Menconi who held leadership positions in IMA for many years and who served as the chair of the IMA Committee on Ethics. He also valued education and taught part time at his alma mater, Northern Illinois University.

The objective of the Competition is to develop and distribute cases focusing on business ethics with specific application to management accounting and finance issues. The cases must utilize the IMA's [Statement of Ethical Professional Practice](#) as a guidance tool/reference. The case should be suitable for either undergraduate or graduate classroom use and/or IMA chapter continuing educational programs. The winning case will be featured in an IMA publication (*Strategic Finance* or *Management Accounting Quarterly*) and the case author or author team will be recognized at the IMA Annual Conference in Baltimore in June 2010.

### Submission Guidelines:

The following three items must be included in all submissions:

1. **Cover page for case** – Please include case title, contact information for all contributing authors including name, title, academic affiliation, mailing address, phone, fax, e-mail and IMA membership status if applicable. If there is more than one author, please designate the primary contact author.
2. **Case** – The case should follow [editorial guidelines](#) for either *Strategic Finance* or *Management Accounting Quarterly*. Please indicate on the cover page which journal is more suitable for your case.
3. **Teaching notes** – Provide teaching notes with reference to IMA's Statement of Ethical Professional Practice. Please include a description of the types of courses or settings where the case may be useful such as classroom, group study, continuing education course, seminar, etc.

### Deadline for Submissions:

Submissions are due by **Friday, January 15, 2010**. The winner(s) will be notified no later than April 30, 2010. Submissions should be sent to the IMA Professor-in-Residence, Raef Lawson, in care of Tara Barker via e-mail at [tbarker@imanet.org](mailto:tbarker@imanet.org).
